## COMMUNITY CHOICE AGGREGATION

For residents and small businesses of the Town of Brookhaven using Natural Gas

March 1, 2023

Dear Residential or Small Business Customer in the Town of Brookhaven:

The Town of Brookhaven is pleased to announce our participation in a Community Choice Aggregation (“CCA”) program administered by Good Energy, that puts control of energy supply choices into local hands. You are receiving this letter because you are newly eligible to participate in the CCA program. Through a competitive procurement process Direct Energy has been selected to replace National Grid as the default supplier of natural gas for residential and small-commercial accounts within our community. We have chosen standard supply as the default product offering for our community.

All eligible residential and small-commercial natural gas customers will be automatically enrolled in the standard supply product beginning with the bill cycle following May 1, 2023 and will be able to continue to receive the CCA program price of \$0.695/Therm for natural gas through May 2025. You may cancel at any time with no fee or penalty.

Below is a comparison of National Grid’s natural gas supply pricing with the CCA program pricing. While this is not indicative of pricing going forward, it does provide a basis for comparison of standard supply offerings.

<b>CCA Natural Gas Supply</b>	69.5 cents/therm	69.5 cents/therm

Please note that if you do not opt-out, you will be enrolled in ESCO service under the contract terms and your information, including energy usage data and APP status, will be provided to Direct Energy.
